

WILLIAMSON-TRAVIS COUNTIES MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1
MAY 8, 2010 DIRECTORS ELECTION

Section 54.102 of the Texas Water Code requires that to be qualified to serve as a Director of the District, a person shall be at least 18 years old, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, and either own land subject to taxation in the District or be a qualified voter within the District.

Section 49.052 of the Texas Water Code provides that a person is disqualified from serving as a Director of the District as provided therein. Chapter 573, Texas Government Code, the nepotism law, applies to Directors of the District.

If a person wishes to apply for a place on the ballot for the upcoming May 8, 2010 Directors election, he or she must complete the application form before a notary public and return the completed form to the District's attorneys, Willatt & Flickinger, 2001 North Lamar, Austin, Texas 78705, attention: Board Secretary, no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 8, 2010. Such forms will be available on the District's website and from the District attorneys, phone: 476-6604.

Applicants should review Section 49.052 of the Texas Water Code and Chapter 573 of the Texas Government Code, copies of which will be provided with each application form and on the District's website.

Three Director positions on the Board are up for election this year. Each position is for a full four-year term. The three candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected.

Under Title 15 of the Election Code, candidates running for an office of a local political subdivision must file campaign contribution and expenditure reports with the secretary of the governing body. The District will make forms for such filings available to each candidate.

Early voting will begin on April 26, 2010.
