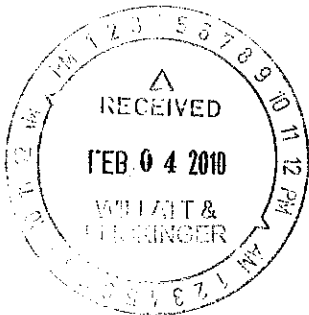



AFFIDAVIT FILED PURSUANT TO § 171.004, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE BY

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Chris W. Rocco, who upon oath deposed and stated;

1. My name is Chris W. Rocco and I am currently the Secretary of the Board of Directors of Williamson-Travis Counties Municipal Utility District No. 1 (the "District").
2. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth below, which are all true and correct, am over 18 years of age, and competent to make this affidavit.
3. I am filing this affidavit with the District to comply with Chapter 171, Texas Local Government Code and to state the nature and extent of a substantial interest in a business entity doing business with the District.
4. My son, John Rocco, is employed by Austin EcoSystems, Inc. Prior to my son's employment with Austin EcoSystems, Inc., the District contracted with Austin EcoSystems, Inc. to perform landscaping services for the District. Austin EcoSystems, Inc. has been the landscaper for the District for a number of years.
5. Prior to January 29, 2010, I was unaware of the requirement to file this affidavit. On that date, I discussed this matter with the District's attorney and was advised that the affidavit should be filed in the circumstances.
6. In conformance with the requirements of Chapter 171, Texas Local Government Code, I shall abstain from any discussion, vote, or decision on any matter involving the District and Austin EcoSystems, Inc., including any budget items specifically dedicated by the District to a contract with Austin EcoSystems, Inc., so long as my son is employed by Austin EcoSystems, Inc.

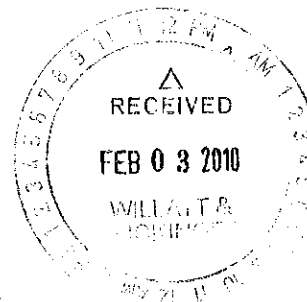

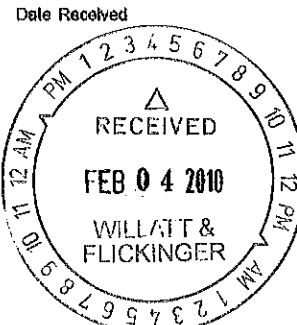
