Registered Instructors must pay, up front, an annual fee of \$500 for residents and \$2500 for non-residents. For fee collection purposes, the year runs from January 1st through December 31st, and annual fees will be prorated for any instructors registering after January 1st. No instruction may be given unless and until this fee has been paid in full.

Once your application is approved and payment is received, you will be issued a security key card that will give you access to the courts. The charge for replacement of lost or stolen security key cards is \$15.

Tennis/pickleball Registered Instructors are responsible for upholding the District's park rules, including, but not limited to, Section 3: General Rules and Regulations for Tennis and Pickleball Courts and Section 4.2: Commercial Use of Tennis/Pickleball Courts.
